Unit 1 – Bath Time

Unit 2 – Family

Grammar Concept A noun names a person.

Punctuation Concept Some words have lowercase and uppercase letters; Some words start with a capital letter.

Skills Letter formation; Sight words; Comprehension; Word recognition; Fine motor skills; Visual discrimination; Following Directions; Visual discrimination; Seeing parts of a whole.

Unit 3 – My Town

Grammar Concept A noun names a place.

Punctuation Concept The first word in a sentence begins with a capital letter.

Skills Letter formation; Sight words; Simple sentences; Comprehension; Word recognition; Fine motor skills; Match words to pictures; Imaginative play.

Unit 4 – At the Pond

Grammar Concept Adjectives can tell how many. Adjectives tell more about a noun.

Punctuation Concept A period at the end of a sentence shows you are done writing.

Skills Letter formation; Number words; Sight words; Simple sentences; Comprehension; Word recognition; Fine motor skills; Counting; Visual discrimination; Shapes; Match words to pictures; Imaginative play.

Unit 5 – Cats

Grammar Concept Adjectives can tell about colours. Adjectives tell more about a noun.

Punctuation Concept A question mark at the end of a sentence shows you are asking a question.

Skills Letter formation; Colour words; Sight words; Simple sentences; Comprehension; Word recognition; Fine motor skills; Visual discrimination; Following Directions; Imaginative play.

Unit 6 – Toy Store

Grammar Concept Adjectives can tell which one or how many. Adjectives tell more about a noun.

Punctuation Concept An exclamation point at the end of a sentence shows you have a strong feeling.

Skills Letter formation; Sight words; Simple sentences; Comprehension; Word recognition; Fine motor skills; Visual discrimination; Seeing parts of a whole.

Unit 7 – Dogs

Grammar Concept An adjective describes a person or animal

Punctuation Concept Some words have lowercase and uppercase letters. Some words start with a capital letter.

Skills Letter formation; Sight words; Simple sentences; Comprehension; Word recognition; Fine motor skills; Visual discrimination; Imaginative play.

Unit 8 – The Farm

Grammar Concept A verb tells the action of a noun.

Punctuation Concept A sentence that ends with a period shows you are done writing.

Punctuation Concept A sentence that ends with a question mark asks a question.

Grammar Concept A pronoun can tell who.

Punctuation Concept A complete sentence ends with a punctuation mark.

Unit 14 – Bugs

Grammar Concept An adverb tells when or where a person, place, thing or animal is.

Punctuation Concept A complete sentence ends with a punctuation mark.

PREPOSITIONS

Unit 15 – Dinosaurs
